

CA-604 - Bakersfield/Kern County CoC Reallocation Process

Over the past seven years, the Bakersfield/Kern County Continuum of Care has completely reallocated six CoC projects and partially reallocated seven other CoC projects to create funding for new projects. In addition, in 2015, one CoC project decided to voluntarily end their CoC grant and another project decided voluntarily to partially reallocate their funding, creating a pool of funds to reallocate. Due to the high performance of the remaining renewal projects, the CoC has determined that it would be detrimental to the CoC and the homeless we serve to reallocate any additional projects in 2015. Therefore, no renewal projects will be reallocated other than those that voluntarily reallocate.

The CoC has determined reallocation funds will be prioritized in the following order:

1. Permanent Supportive Housing for the Chronically Homeless
2. Rapid Re-Housing
3. SSO for centralized/coordinated assessment
4. HMIS project
